

NAMING OF SETTINGS IN SECTION I

The Children and Families Act 2014 secures the general presumption in law that children and young people with SEND should be educated within a mainstream setting.

Section 33(2) Children and Families Act 2014 states that:

“The LA must secure that the plan provides for the child or young person to be educated in a mainstream placement, unless that is incompatible with:

- a) the wishes of the child’s parent or the young person, or*
- b) the provision of efficient education for others.”*

Where the parent/carer/young person, expresses a preference for a setting, Section 39(4) Children and Families Act 2014 states that:

The LA must secure that the EHC plan names the school or other institution requested by parent or YP unless:

- a) the school or other institution requested is unsuitable for the age, ability, aptitude or special educational needs of the CYP concerned, or*
- b) the attendance of the CYP at the requested school or other institution would be incompatible with—*
 - i. the provision of efficient education for others, or*
 - ii. the efficient use of resources.*

All decisions about placement should be underpinned by an expectation that all avenues for a mainstream education should be exhausted, through reasonable adjustments, best endeavours, and provision of additional resource. Parents and young people should be supported to understand how a mainstream setting can meet the CYP's needs.

SEND Panel determines the LA view on the setting the LA thinks would be appropriate for the CYP. This does not override the parental/YP preference but provides officers with the LA's view on the type of setting which should be named if we cannot name the preferred setting.

There are very limited circumstances where Section I should name a type of setting, especially mainstream.

The decision trees below will support officers in their decision-making regarding Section I. If no consultation response is received, officers should follow the negative response process.

Blue – preference and LA view

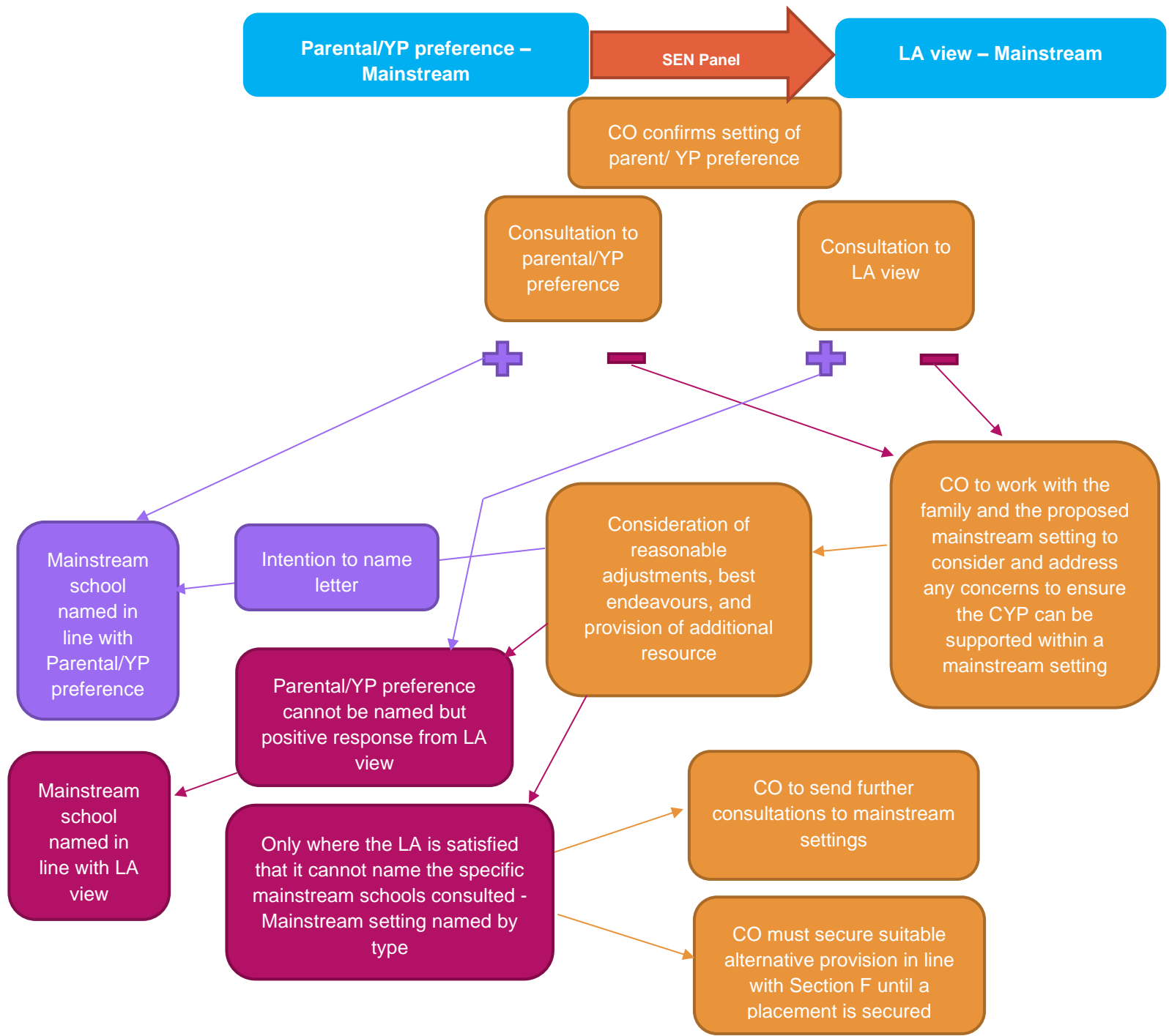
Yellow – actions for CO/PO

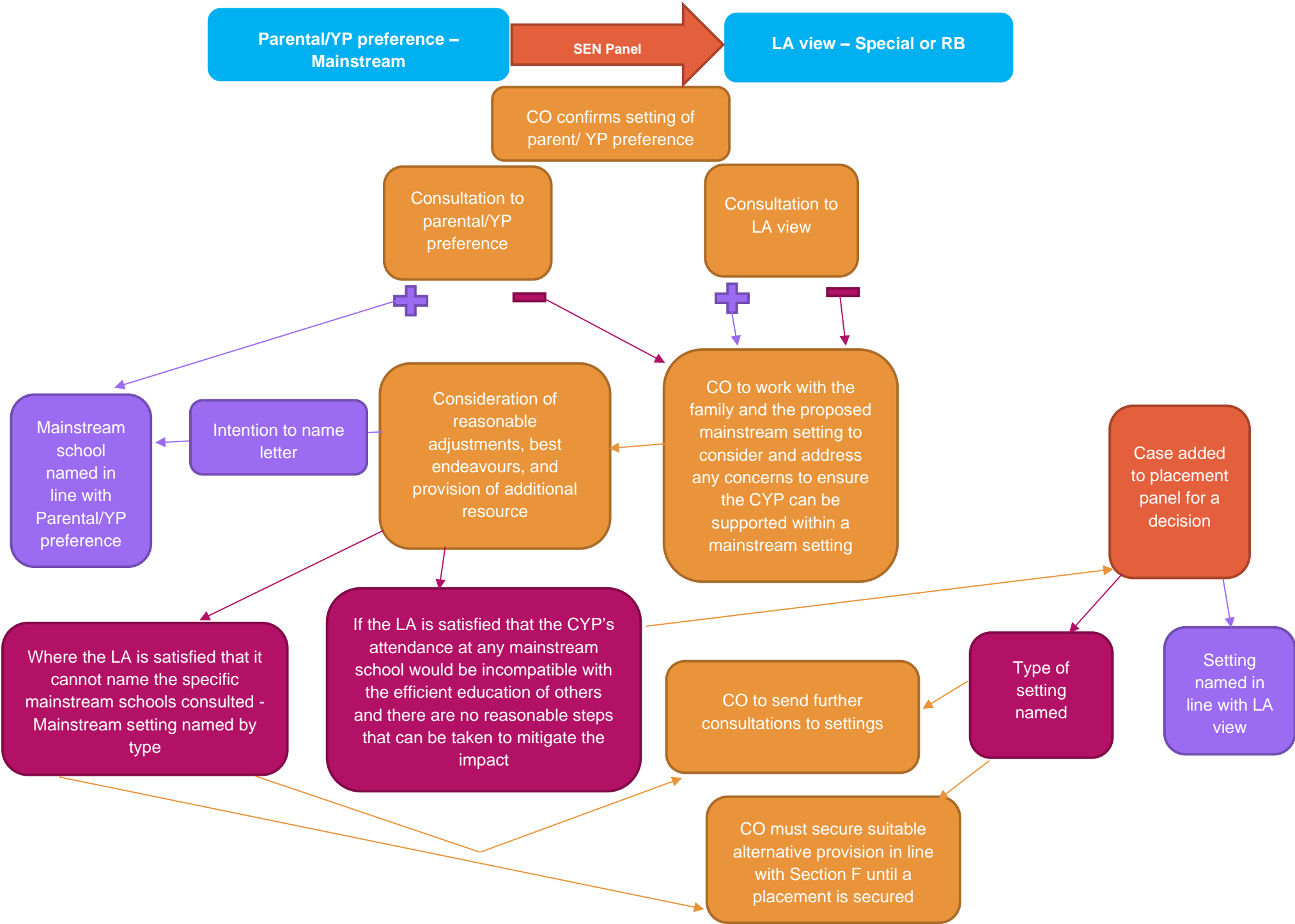
Orange – decision making

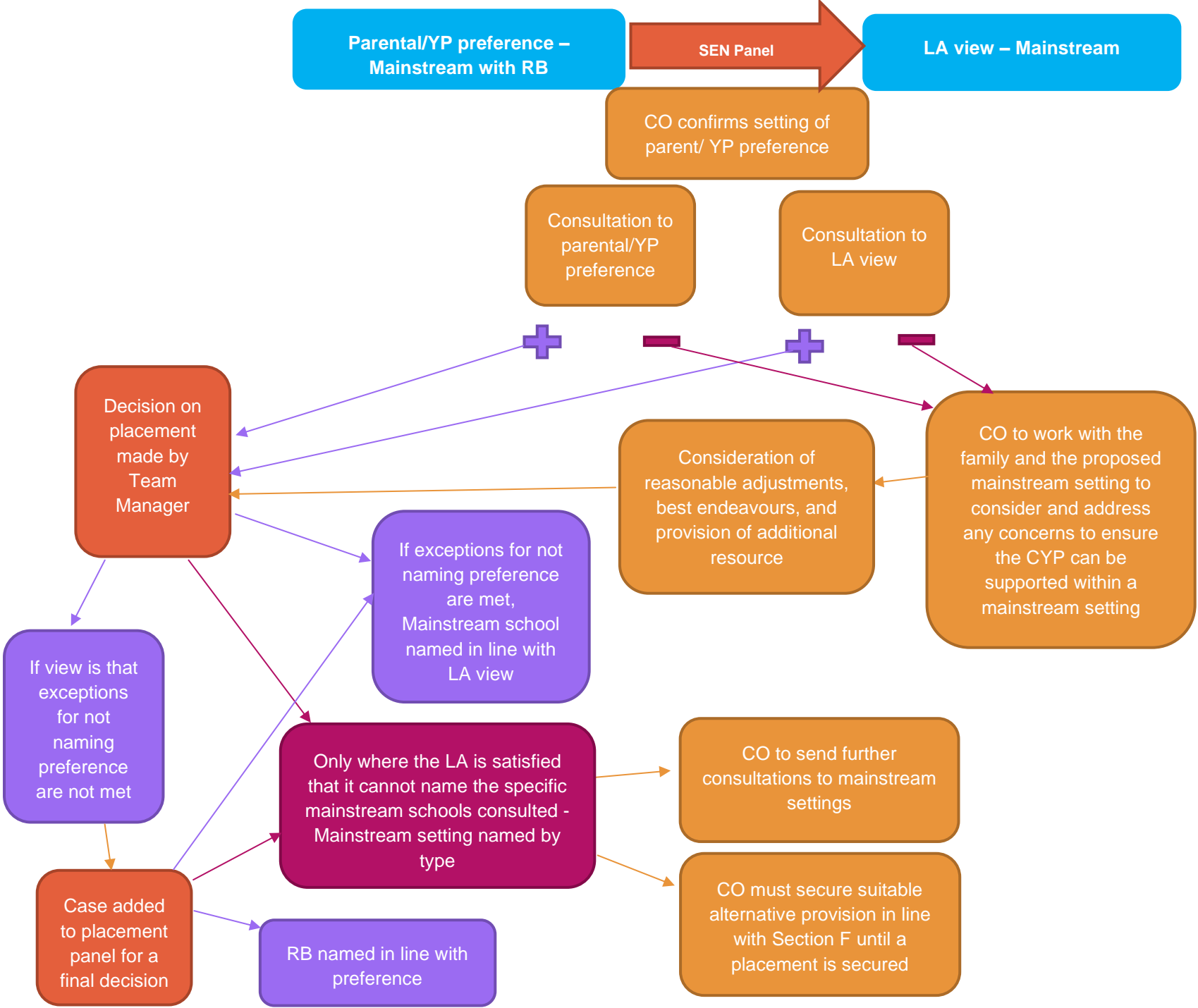
Only where the LA is satisfied that it cannot name the specific mainstream schools consulted - Mainstream setting named by type

Attendance at mainstream CAN be supported

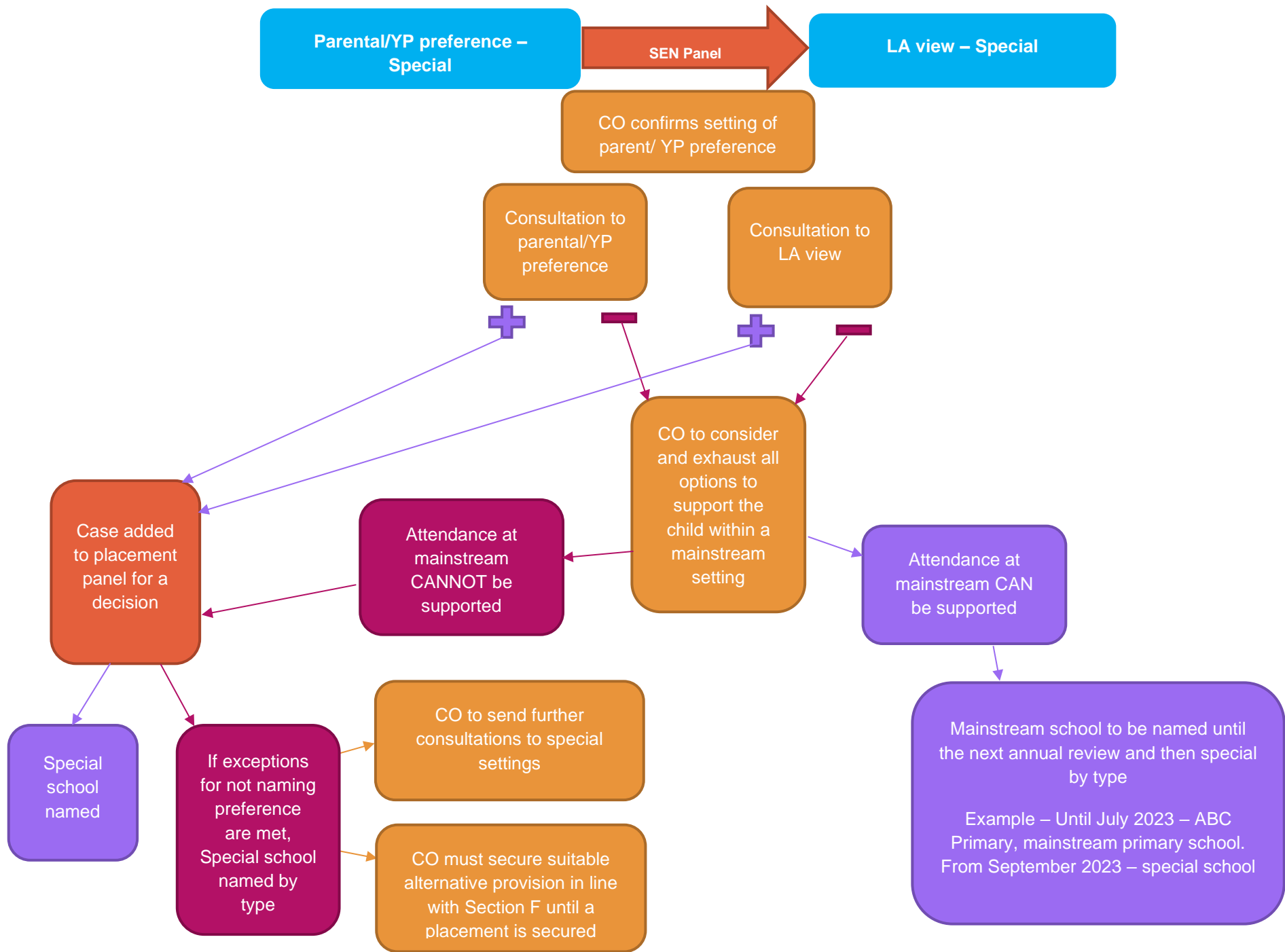
Mainstream school to be named until the next annual review and then special by type
Example – Until July 2023 – ABC Primary, mainstream primary school.
From September 2023 – special school

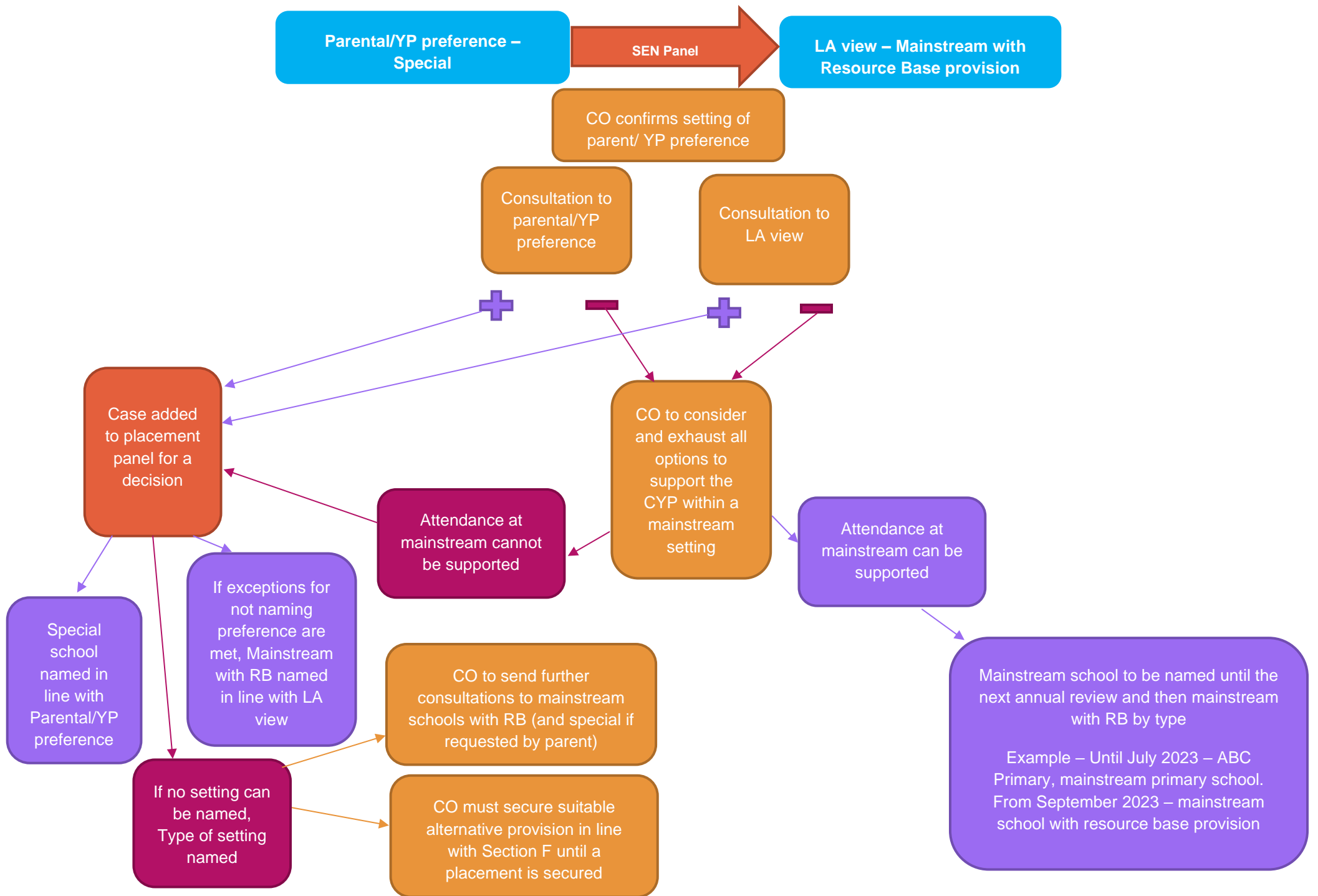
If no setting can be named - Type of setting

If preference cannot be named, Mainstream school named in line with LA view

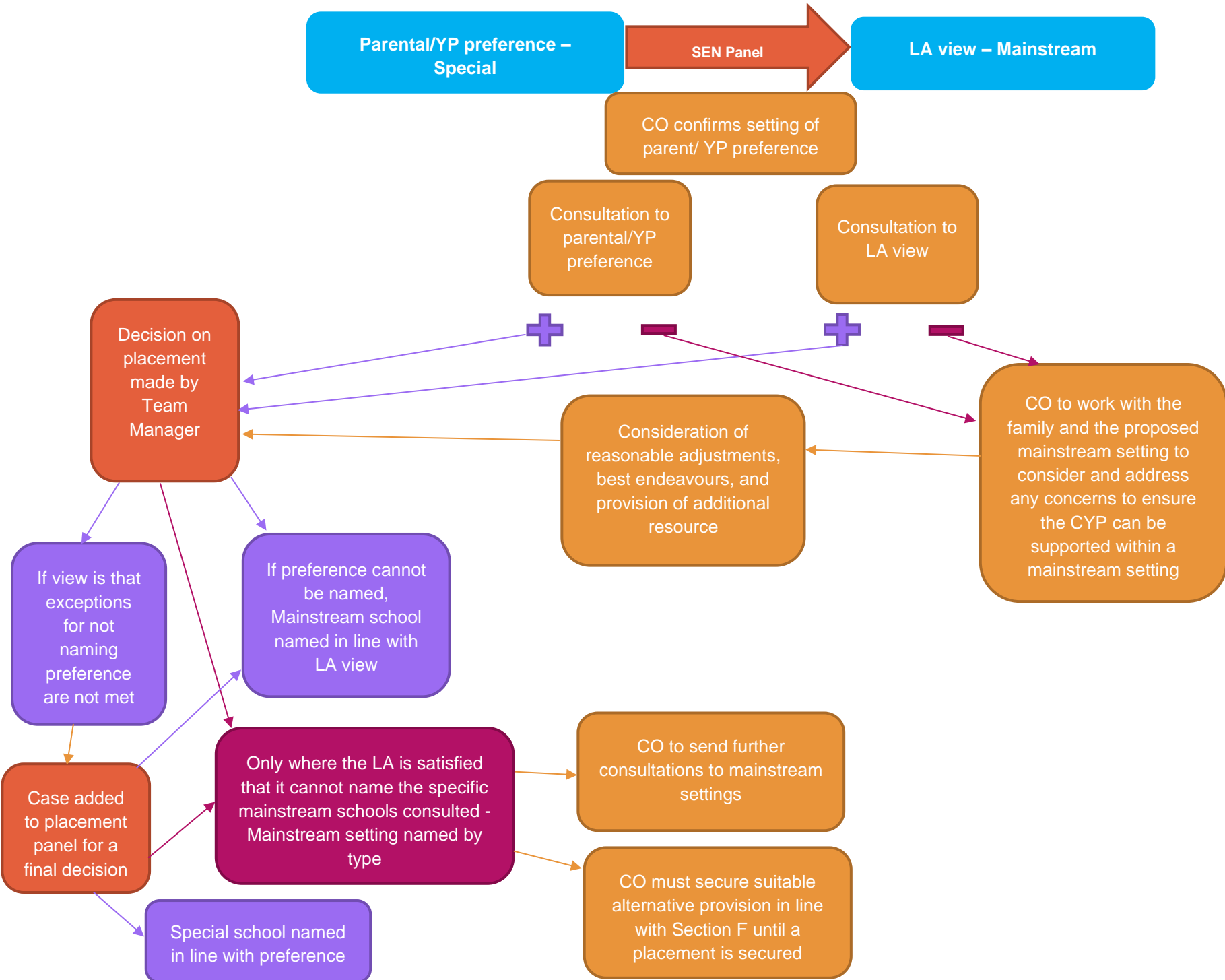
